

Record of Proceedings Town of Elmer City April 16, 2026

The Town of Elmer City Council met in regular session at 505 Seaton Ave, Elmer City, Washington on the 16th day of April 2026. Mayor Jesse Tillman, City Councilmembers William Dunlap, Flora Long, Terje Berg, and Maintenance/Water Specialist Jimmer Tillman and Clerk/Treasurer Kelly Ross were in attendance or present via zoom.

Mayor Jesse Tillman opened the meeting at 5:30 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approve Meeting Minutes:

Bill moved to approve the March 12, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes. Terje seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Report:

Jesse gave a brief overview of the meeting with Trible council, and we may be able to change the scope of work with the grant/loan from the Department of Ecology.

Old Business:

Bill moved to approve the contract for Professional Engineering Services, Gray & Osborne, Wastewater Facility Plan. Flora seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

New Business:

Kelly explained there are a few parcels out of city limits that would be beneficial to annex into city limits. And the Periodic Update will include these parcels and the Trible professional housing area as a proposed urban growth area.

After some discussion, Flora moved to approved to move forward with the sale of two surplus real property the town owns. Bill seconded the motion, all were in favor, motion carried.

Public Comment Period per RCW 42.30:

No public was in attendance.

Maintenance/Water Specialist Report:

Jimmer reported that, he and Kelly attended a Federal Partners Coalition meeting in Pasco, and we spoke to Kirt Pearson regarding our issues with Coulee Dam and their wastewater treatment plant.

Clerk/Treasurer Report:

Kelly stated that Gray and Osborne will apply for a RCO planning grant for recreation access for the improvements to Seaton Park.

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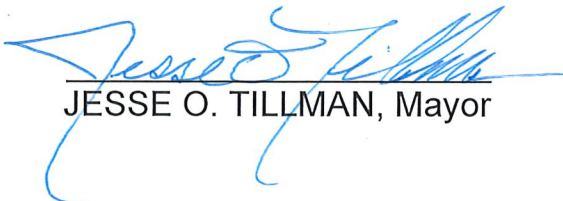
